1. INTERIM DECISION:

- **1.1 AT** the conclusion of the hearing the Tribunal retired to consider it's findings. The findings which follow were made on 14 December 1998.
- **1.2 WITH** the exception of the Particular framed by the Tribunal itself at the end of the CAC case, the Tribunal finds that the facts alleged in the charge have been proved to the required standard.
- **1.3 THE** Tribunal is not satisfied that the facts alleged in the sixth Particular of the Charge, relating to unsecured borrowing of approximately \$27,000, have been established.
- **1.4 HAVING** so found, the Tribunal determines that the conduct established by the proven facts amounts to disgraceful conduct in a professional respect.
- **1.5 FULL** reasons for the Tribunal's findings and determination will be provided in a written Decision which will be delivered as early as possible in 1999.
