DECISION ON APPLICATION FOR NAME SUPPRESSION

1. Counsel for the Respondent, Ms Phipps, has made application under section

106(2)(d) of the Medical Practitioners Act 1995 for an interim order

suppressing the name of the doctor and any information that might lead to his

identification until the commencement of the hearing.

2. At the Directions Conference on 27 May 2003 it was agreed that any

applications for name suppression were to be received no later than 11 June

2003. No application on behalf of Dr Hauptfleisch was received by that date.

Ms Phipps was overseas from 3 July to 23 July and during her absence this

application and an accompanying affidavit was discovered on the file. The

hearing is set down to proceed on 28 and 29 July. Because of the proximity

of the hearing the effect of any interim order is somewhat limited but the

Tribunal wishes to advise the parties of its decision as soon as possible. It is

not possible in the time available to complete the full decision before the

hearing commences and accordingly the Tribunal advises that it has declined

the application for interim name suppression for reasons that are to follow.
