NOTICE OF TRIBUNAL'S DECISION IN RELATION TO APPLICATION

BY CAC TO AMEND THE CHARGE

1. Doctor C has been charged by a CAC with conduct unbecoming a medical practitioner which

reflects adversely upon his fitness to practise.

2. On 13 May 2004 the CAC applied to the Tribunal to amend the charge to one of professional

misconduct and, in the alternative, conduct unbecoming which reflects adversely on the

practitioner's fitness to practise.

3. The Tribunal convened by way of telephone conference on the evening of 7 June 2004 to

consider the CAC's application. The Tribunal has unanimously granted the CAC's

application.

4. The reasons for the Tribunal granting the application will be delivered as soon as reasonably

practicable. It is anticipated that the Tribunal's reasons for its decision will not be available

until mid July
